The above parties conclude this Licence to publish agreement (the “Licence Agreement”), governed by the Act No. 185/2015 Coll. on Copyright and Related Rights (as amended by Act No. 125/2016 Coll. (the “Copyright and Related Rights Act”) and Act. 40/1964 Coll., as amended.

Part II.
Subject, way and period of use of work

1. Under this Licence Agreement the Author/Co-authors grant the Journal Owner licence and authorisation to use the work specified in Section 2 of this Part (the “Licence”) under the conditions specified in this Licence Agreement.
Title of work: *Nanoparticles crossing the blood brain barrier (review article)*
(the “Work”)
2. Use of the Work:
 - a) Publication and public distribution of the Work,
 - b) Distribution of the Work,
 - c) Selling of the Work in the University shop and the University e-shop,
 - d) Publication of the journal cover on the website of the Journal Owner and on the list of published works,
 - e) Publication of the journal cover and the journal content on the website of the University e-shop,
 - f) Publication of the journal cover and the journal content in online libraries catalogues,
 - g) Publication of the Work or its parts in promotional materials, journals or daily papers or its inclusion in any database.
3. The Author/Co-authors of the Work grant to the Journal Owner the licence to publish and distribute the Work for the period of 20 years.
4. The parties agree that the Author/Co-authors grant the licence for use of the work specified in Part 2, Section 2 of this agreement free of charge.

Part III.
Conditions

1. The Author/Co-authors warrantee that:
 - a) they are entitled without limitation to grant the Licence to publish their work,
 - b) text, figures and tables presented in the work are products of their own creative activities,
 - c) they did not use results obtained by other authors without their consent,
 - d) citations presented in the work are properly reported, their number complies with the work subject matter and no excessive number of citations is used to support one point. The author, title and the source of citations are provided,
 - e) the work was prepared in agreement with the latest professional, scientific and didactic knowledge in the respective field,
 - f) the manuscript is written in agreement with relevant grammar rules of the respective language,
 - g) the professional terminology, symbols and units comply with the relevant state standards,

- h) figures (drawings and photographs) are of good quality and reproducibility,
 - i) the submitted manuscript is not the only exemplar and another complete identical copy of the manuscript is available,
 - j) they are liable for damages arising from untruthfulness of these statements.
2. The Author/Co-authors provide complete version of work in an electronic form to the person authorised by the Journal Owner.
 3. The Journal Owner is obliged to publish the work.
 4. The Journal Owner shall ensure editorial and technical adjustment of the work and its sending to the Author/Co-authors for the Author's correction. The Author/Co-authors agree to perform this correction free of charge.
 5. The Journal Owner decides about graphical and technical adjustment, format, colour scheme, paper and binding of work, taking into consideration economy and, within limits, suggestions of the Author/Co-authors.
 6. The Journal Owner shall ensure publication, distribution and spreading of work at one's own expenses.

Concluding provisions

3. This agreement is prepared in five original copies, two for the Journal Owner and one for the Author (and each of the Co-authors).

The parties to this agreement declare that they have read the agreement, have understood it, consider it sufficiently comprehensible, clear and unequivocal, have not concluded it in distress or under otherwise markedly disadvantageous conditions or under psychological or physical pressure and signify their agreement by their signatures below.
